


SERVICE HIGHLIGHTS:

- Active licenses increased 9.3% from June 2016 to June 2017.
- The largest component is individual license to carry holders/instructor certificates, which constitutes 89% of the total. Active LTCs increased 12.8% from June 2016 to June 2017.


Handgun Licenses and/or Registrations Issued



Handgun Licensing Highlights:

- 116,989 total licenses issued June YTD: 170,386 were issued during the same period in 2016.
- June YTD: 44% of those were original and 56% renewals.
- Average 19,498/month mailed January-June 2017 compared to 28,398 in the same period 2016.
- An additional 67,320 licenses were mailed January-June 2017 (composed of licenses subject to review, re-mails, returns by post office, address/name changes and lost/stolen replacements).

Private Security Licenses and/or Registrations Issued




Private Security Licensing Highlights:

- 47,629 total licenses issued June 2017 YTD: 24,958 new (52.4%) and 22,671 renewals (47.6%).
- 3.4% increase in licenses issued June 2017 YTD over June 2016.

Metals Recycling Licensing Highlights:


- 222 total licenses issued January-June 2017: 24 original (10.8% of total) and 198 renewals (89.2%).

- Certificates of registration are valid for two years; odd number years tend to have more activity.


COMPLIANCE & ENFORCEMENT SERVICES

Active Vehicle Inspection Entities



HIGHLIGHTS:

- 54,341 total active stations and inspectors as of June 2017, represents 10.1% decrease from June 2016 total.
- Inspector licenses expire 8/31 in even numbered years. Station licenses expire 8/31 in odd numbered years. Any license not renewed by the renewal date is made inactive.



HIGHLIGHTS:


- June YTD audits total 52,478 or a 10.2% increase from the June 2016 YTD total of 47,641.



Administrative Investigations




- Averaged 10/month for CY2015 and 22/month CY2016.

Inspections




- Averaged 232/month in CY2015 and 214/month in 2016.
- Total of 1,764 for January-June 2017, compared to 1,623 for the same period in 2016. Averaging 294 inspections per month in 2017.



REGULATORY CRIMES SERVICE (cont'd.)

- Total of 85 for January-June 2017 compared to 94 for the same period in 2016. Averaging 14/month in CY2017.



- 246 total referrals each in CY2015 and 282 referrals in CY2016.
- Averaged 21 and 24 per month respectively.
- Total of 132 for January-June 2017 compared to 120 for the same period in 2016.
 Averaging 22/month in 2017.
