


SERVICE HIGHLIGHTS:

- Total Regulatory active licenses: 1,367,000.
- Active licenses increased 7.9% from August 2016 to August 2017.
- The largest component is individual license to carry holders/instructor certificates, which constitutes 89% of the total. Active LTCs increased 10.7% from August 2016 to August 2017.


Handgun Licenses and/or Registrations Issued



Handgun Licensing Highlights:

- 150,097 total licenses issued August CYTD: 213,886 were issued during the same period in 2016.
- August CYTD: 41% of those were original and 59% renewals.
- Average 18,762/month mailed January-August 2017 compared to 26,736 in the same period 2016.
- An additional 91,740 licenses were mailed January-August 2017 (composed of licenses subject to review, re-mails, returns by post office, address/name changes and lost/stolen replacements).

Private Security Licenses and/or Registrations Issued




Private Security Licensing Highlights:

- 64,376 total licenses issued August 2017 CYTD: 34,146 new (53.0%) and 30,230 renewals (47.0%).
- 11.0% increase in licenses issued August 2017 YTD over August 2016.

Metals Recycling Licensing Highlights:


- 312 total licenses issued January-August 2017: 38 original (12.2% of total) and 274 renewals (87.8%).
- Equates to a 108.0% increase from August 2016 to August 2017.
- Certificates of registration are valid for two years; odd number years tend to have more activity.


COMPLIANCE & ENFORCEMENT SERVICES

Active Vehicle Inspection Entities



HIGHLIGHTS:

- 55,711 total active stations and inspectors as of August 2017, represents 10.1% decrease from August 2016 total
- Inspector licenses expire 8/31 in even numbered years. Station licenses expire 8/31 in odd numbered years. Any license not renewed by the renewal date is made inactive.



HIGHLIGHTS:


- August YTD audits total 69,383 or an 8.3% increase from the August 2016 YTD total of 64,093.



Administrative Investigations




- Averaged 10/month for CY2015 and 22/month CY2016.

Inspections




- Averaged 232/month in CY2015 and 214/month in 2016.
- Total of 2,236 for January-August 2017, compared to 1,940 for the same period in 2016. Averaging 280 inspections per month in 2017.



REGULATORY CRIMES SERVICE (cont'd.)



- Average of 18/month in CY15 and 12/month in 2016.
- Total of 100 for January-August 2017 compared to 118 for the same period in 2016. Averaging 13/month in CY2017.



- 246 total referrals each in CY2015 and 282 referrals in CY2016.
- Averaged 21 and 24 per month respectively.
- Total of 166 for January-August 2017 compared to 150 for the same period in 2016. Averaging 21/month in 2017.
