Name. The name may include alphabetics, numerics, a comma, hyphen(s), and spaces. The comma must follow the last name. The hyphen cannot be in the first position or directly precede the comma.

Date of Birth in YYYYMMDD format
FBI Number. One to nine alphanumerics.

Miscellaneous Number. Alphanumeric. The first two characters must be a valid NCIC-assigned code. The third character must be a hyphen. Positions 4 through 15 must not contain a single zero or a run of zeros only.
Social Security Number

Operator License Number. Alphanumeric. Single zero only or run of zeros only may not be used.

License Plate Number. If the license plate number exceeds ten characters, only the last ten characters should be used.

Vehicle Identification Number. Alphanumeric. Single zero only, run of zeros only, single alphabetic only, all alphabetics only, or spaces cannot be used.

Related Search Hit. Must be either Y or N .
Expanded Name Search. Must be either Y or N.

Sex. $M=$ male or $F=$ female.
Race. A=Asian or Pacific Islander, B=Black, I=American Indian or Alaskan Native, $\mathrm{W}=$ White, or $\mathrm{U}=$ Unknown

Expanded Date of Birth Search. Must be either 1, 2, 3 or blank. EBS codes 2 and 3 in effective use April 1, 2007.

Name. The name may include alphabetics, numerics, a comma, hyphen(s), and spaces. The comma must follow the last name. The hyphen cannot be in the first position or directly precede the comma.

Originating Case Number. The only valid special characters are the hyphen and the space. Other exceptions are described in the NCIC 2000 Operating Manual.

License Plate Number. If the license plate number exceeds ten characters, only the last ten characters should be used.

License Plate State. Code as defined in the NCIC 2000 Code Manual.

Related Search Hit. Must be either Y or N .

Vehicle Identification Number. Alphanumeric. Single zero only, run of zeros only, single alphabetic only, all alphabetics only, or spaces cannot be used.
Vehicle Make. Code as defined in the NCIC 2000 Code Manual.

Related Search Hit. Must be either Y or N .

Zip Code. Five numerics, or ten characters with five numerics followed by a hyphen and another four numerics. Example: 77777 or 99999-9999.

Sex Offender Status. Must be either Y or N. If field contains Y or blank, only active records will be returned. If field contains N , then active, expired, and inactive records will be returned.
