Operator License Number. Alphanumeric. Single zero only or run of zeros only may not be used.
Operator License State. Code as defined in the NCIC 2000 Code Manual.
Operator License Year. Must represent the year the license expires (YYYY) or the alphabetics ' $N X$ ' to represent a non-expiring license.
License Plate Set. If one is entered all are required. Each Set of license plate data must be preceded by MFC.
License Plate Number. If the license plate number exceeds ten characters, only the last ten characters should be used. If the LIC is UNK, UNKN, or UNKNOWN, contact NCIC CJIS Division for assistance.
License Plate State. Code as defined in the NCIC 2000 Code Manual.
License Plate Year. Must represent the year the license plate expires (YYYY) or the alphabetics 'NX' to represent a nonexpiring license plate.
License Plate Type. Code as defined in the NCIC 2000 Code Manual.
Vehicular Data Set. VIN, VYR, VMA, and VST are required. If VMO or VCO is excluded, a placeholder period should be included in the stream.
Vehicle Identification Number. Alphanumeric. Single zero only, run of zeros only, single alphabetic only, all alphabetics only, or spaces cannot be used.
Vehicle Make. Code as defined in the NCIC 2000 Code Manual.
