

## Message formats for Wanted Person Detainer Transactions

### DW -- Enter Wanted Person Detainer

*Note: Entry formats are positional. All fields must be accounted for with a period even if the field is not mandatory. Field prefixes are not permitted. A "Cond. Set" means that if one of the fields is entered all of the fields in the set are required. A "One of Set" means that at least one of the fields in the set is required.*

#### Message Structure:

#### Such That:

ssss	4	Mnemonic of Sending Device
rrrr	4	Mnemonic of Receiving Device
cccccccc	1-10	Control Field; Used for routing within the interface system
.<ori>	9	Agency's FBI assigned Originating Agency Identifier

#### Followed By (Selection Criteria):

.NAM/<nam>	3-30	Name. The name may include alphabetic, numerics, a comma, hyphen(s), and spaces. The comma must follow the last name. The hyphen cannot be in the first position or directly precede the comma.
.OCA/<oca>	1-20	Originating Case Number. The only valid special characters are the hyphen and the space. Other exceptions are described in the NCIC 2000 Operating Manual.

#### Followed By:

.<dod>	8	Required	Date of Detainer in YYYYMMDD format.
.<dno>	1-20	Required	Detainer Case Number. The only valid special characters are the hyphen and the space. Other exceptions are described in the NCIC 2000 Operating Manual.
.<iri>	9	Required	Incarcerating Agency Identifier
.<dis>	8		Date Incarceration Starts in YYYYMMDD format.
.<dse>	8		Date of Sentence Expiration in YYYYMMDD format.
.<inc>	1-50		Place of Incarceration. Free text. Alphanumeric and special characters.

## **XDW -- Cancel Wanted Person Detainer**

### Message Structure:

{ssss}TCC#\$1N01rrrr ccccccccc.XDW.<ori>

ssss	4	Mnemonic of Sending Device
rrrr	4	Mnemonic of Receiving Device
cccccccc	1-10	Control Field; Used for routing within the interface system
.<ori>	9	Agency's FBI assigned Originating Agency Identifier

#### *Followed By (Selection Criteria):*

.NAM/<nam>	3-30	Name. The name may include alphabetic, numeric, a comma, hyphen(s), and spaces. The comma must follow the last name. The hyphen cannot be in the first position or directly precede the comma.
.OCA/<oca>	1-20	Originating Case Number. The only valid special characters are the hyphen and the space. Other exceptions are described in the NCIC 2000 Operating Manual.
