# Suggestions for Helping Yourself Through Grief

#### Take care of yourself

It is important to get adequate rest and eat balanced meals. Helpful tips include limiting caffeine, going to bed earlier, decreasing junk food, and increasing movement. Try reading books, taking a hot bath, journaling, or volunteering.

#### Give yourself permission to grieve

Grief can bring on many emotions such as anger, irritability, or sadness. Everyone grieves differently. Be patient with yourself and others during this period. Give yourself permission to express your feelings in a healthy way.

#### **Seek support**

Ask for help from your support system and seek the help of a counselor or clergy member. During this time, try socializing with friends, and telling stories about your loved one.
